## AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE DIVISION OF MEDICAID AND THE MISSISSIPPI BOARD OF PHARMACY

## (Prescription Monitoring Program Claims Data Sharing)

THIS AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO modifies, revises, and amends the Memorandum of Understanding, entered into by and between the DIVISION OF MEDICAID in the OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, an administrative agency of the STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, hereinafter referred to as "DOM," and THE MISSISSIPPI BOARD OF PHARMACY, hereinafter referred to as "BOP."

WHEREAS, the parties have entered into a MOU in order to allow their respective vendors to share Medicaid Prescription Monitoring Program claims data directly in accordance with Miss. Code Ann. § 73-21-127; and,

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the MOU to extend the term of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, DOM and BOP agree the MOU is amended as follows:

- 1. Article 3 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following paragraph:
  - III. TERM: The term of this MOU shall commence on December 15, 2015 and shall remain in force through December 31, 2020, unless terminated earlier by any party in accordance with paragraph VIII, Termination. This MOU may be renewed for an additional one year term if mutually agreed upon in writing by DOM and BOP.
- 2. Except as otherwise amended herein, all other provisions of the MOU remain in full force and effect.
