# Eligibility Requirements

## Women and Men Between the Ages of 13-44

- Must be capable of reproducing
- Family income is at or below 194% of the federal poverty level (FPL)
- Must not have Medicare, Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) coverage, or any other health insurance or third party medical coverage
- Women cannot be pregnant

# Loss of Eligibility Occurs When

- A beneficiary moves from the state of Mississippi,
- becomes eligible for another Medicaid aid category, Medicare, CHIP, or other health insurance,
- becomes pregnant, or
- reaches 45 years of age.

# Covered Services

- Four annual visits (Federal FY October – September)
- Family Planning and Family Planning Related Services
- Treatment of sexually transmitted infections (STIs), sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) and abnormal pap smears
- Voluntary sterilization

Effective Jan. 1, 2015, beneficiaries enrolled in the Family Planning waiver demonstration program may have a prescription for contraceptives and/or medications to treat a sexually transmitted infection (STI)/sexually transmitted disease (STD) written by any Medicaid participating provider filled at their local Medicaid participating pharmacy.

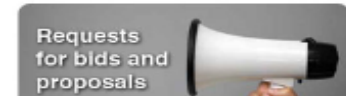
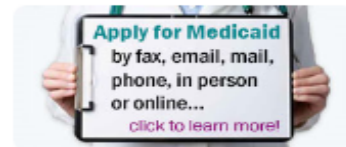

### Other Programs

#### [Family Planning Waiver](#)

The Family Planning Waiver program is for women and men who receive Medicaid benefits limited solely to family planning services. This includes one annual visit and subsequent visits related to their birth control methods. These women will not be eligible to receive any other Medicaid benefits.

#### [Hospice](#)

Hospice Benefit is a State Plan service for terminally ill individuals at the end of their life cycle and having certification from a physician with a life expectancy of six (6) months or less. Hospice provides palliative treatment such as nursing care, medical social services, physician services, counseling short term patient care, medical appliances and supplies, drugs related to terminal condition, home health aide or homemaker, or non-restorative therapies.

#### [Healthier Mississippi Waiver](#)

This waiver covers individuals who are not eligible for Medicare. Once Medicare starts, eligibility for the Healthier MS Waiver ends. [For more information, view the Healthier Mississippi Waiver brochure.](#)

#### [Mississippi Access to Care \(MAC\) 2.0](#)

Mississippi Access to Care 2.0 is a continuation of Mississippi's earlier efforts in long term care reform. Its purpose and that of the stakeholder groups is to bring together any and all projects that support home and community based services and community living for seniors and individuals with disabilities.
