### Notice to Participants, Caregivers & Providers

The Mississippi Division of Medicaid (DOM) Office of Long Term Care requests your feedback in the renewal of the 1915(c) Home and Community Based Elderly and Disabled Waiver. DOM is seeking input regarding recommended changes from participants, caregivers, providers, and other community stakeholders prior to the submission of the renewal application to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Comments or recommendations specific to this waiver must be received by December 31, 2022.

### Elderly and Disabled Waiver Basics

The Elderly and Disabled Waiver is a statewide program administered and operated by the DOM. It is designed to offer assistance and services in a home or community-based setting for those who meet the criteria and qualify for Medicaid. The program allows persons to receive services and supports in their home as an alternative to nursing facility care or other institutional care.
