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Beneficiary Health Management

Medicaid, authorized by Title XIX of the Social Security Act, is a federal and state program of medical assistance to qualified individuals. Each state designates a state agency as the single state agency for the administration of Medicaid. State law designated the Division of Medicaid, Office of the Governor, as the single state agency to administer the Medicaid program in Mississippi.

The Division of Medicaid's Bureau of Program Integrity has the responsibility of initiating and coordinating BHM.

This program may include physician only, pharmacy only or physician and pharmacy type beneficiary health management.
