



AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO TO RFP #20131025 – Release Date of 02/06/2014

RE: RFP #20131025 Implementation and Operation Services for the Mississippi Enterprise Solution and Fiscal Agent Services

Notice to Offerors:

DOM has identified additional technical requirements that are requisites of the MES and are included in the attached spreadsheet. DOM hereby amends section 7.11.5, Technical Requirements, to add the following category type: HIPAA Privacy and Security Requirements. Detailed requirements are described in Appendix U, attached hereto. Offerors shall respond to each requirement as specified in Section 7.11.5 of the RFP and indicate if they agree to meet the requirement as stated or propose an alternate process to meet the requirement. The Offeror should also reference the appropriate Proposal Section for the proposed solution. The Offeror's response to these requirements should be placed in Tab 19 and follow instructions as outlined in Section 5.20 of the RFP.

The Offeror shall provide a summary description of the approach to completing the Contractor's responsibilities of the technical requirements as specified in Section 5.17, Tab 16, of the RFP. The Offeror must present any assumptions or constraints identified for the Technical Requirements.

The DOM wants to gain an understanding of the efficiencies that the Offeror's proposed system may offer as they relate to the HIPAA Privacy and Security requirements. The Offeror is advised that the response to the HIPAA requirements will be evaluated but will not be individually scored.

Procurement regulations require that Offerors acknowledge in writing all amendments to the RFP as specified in Section 9.1 of the RFP. The Offeror shall sign the Amendment Acknowledgement Form as attached and include this form along with a statement in the transmittal letter acknowledging receipt of this Amendment Number Two in their proposal response.

In addition to the above amendment, DOM hereby amends Appendix L, *Mandatory Requirements Checklist*, to incorporate DOM responses to the RFP questions.
