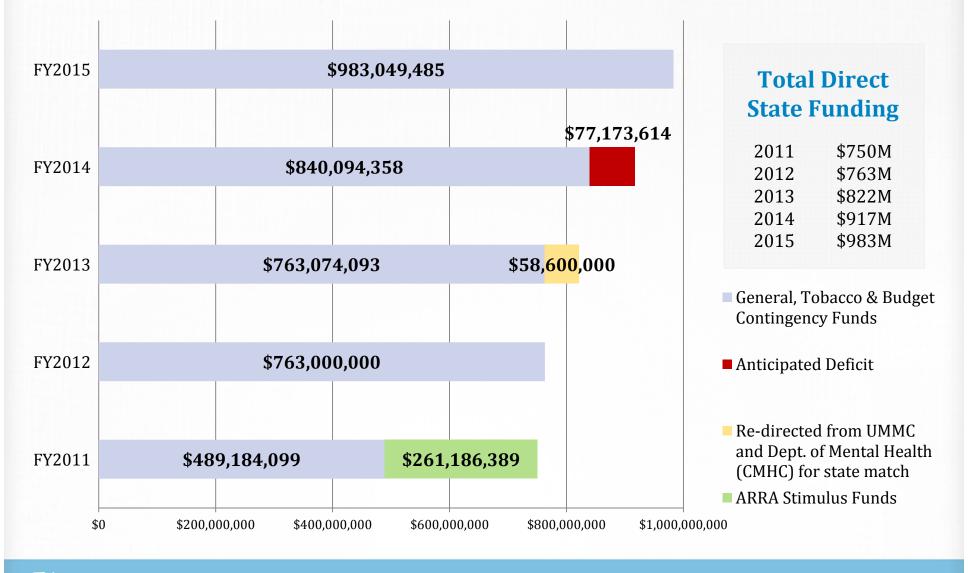

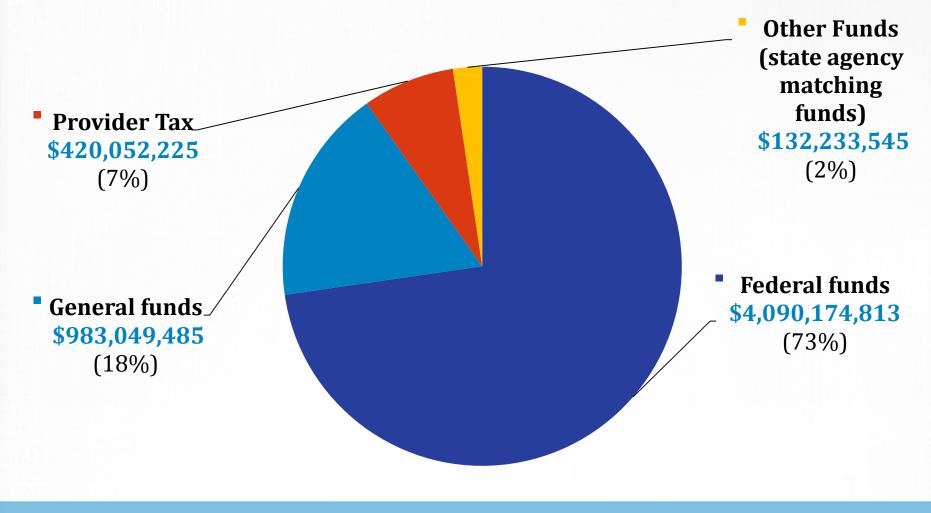
2015 Direct State Funding
