APPLICATION AND REDETERMINATION PROCESSING COVERAGE PERIODS FOR MEDICAID

The case record must be documented with the out-of-state contact and the response concerning payment.

2. At-Home Eligible If a Medicaid client living at home in another state enters a a Mississippi nursing home, the same procedures as outlined in 1 above applies. An individual living at home, who applies for Medicaid, must have the beginning date of eligibility coordinated with the former state of residence. The same procedure outlined in 1 above is necessary regarding contact with the state of former residence to determine when Medicaid will terminate and whether out-of-state payment of claims is customary. If no out of State payment is anticipated, eligibility can begin with the month of the move to Mississippi if eligible on all other factors.

D. TERMINATION Medicaid coverage for a recipient will end on one of DATES FOR the following days of the month: MEDICAID

- The last day of the last month in which the client was eligible.
- The death date of the recipient.
