

Limited Income NET Program Quick Reference Guide

LI NET Program Eligibility

Note that individuals must have Medicare and Medicaid or the Low-Income Subsidy (LIS) and must not be enrolled in any other Medicare Part D prescription drug plan.

To Submit a Claim

Use the 4Rx data in the patient's LI NET Program enrollment confirmation letter using the Medicare Claim Number (on the Red, White and Blue Medicare card). If the patient does not have a letter, use the 4Rx data below.

About the Limited Income NET (LI NET) Program

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) created this program to provide:

1. **Point-of-sale** prescription drug coverage for individuals with Medicare's Low-Income Subsidy (LIS) – “Extra Help” – who are not yet enrolled in a Medicare Part D prescription drug plan.
2. **Retroactive** prescription drug coverage for new “dual eligibles” – those individuals who are newly eligible for both Medicare and Medicaid or Medicare and Supplemental Security Income (SSI).

Temporary Coverage

All LI NET enrollees are **temporarily** covered by Medicare's LI NET Program while CMS enrolls them in a standard Medicare Part D plan.



There is not an LI NET Program ID card. If the patient has an LI NET Program enrollment confirmation letter, use the 4Rx data provided. If not, follow the four steps shown at right.

Four Steps for Pharmacy Providers

1 Request Plan ID Card
If the patient has a Part D plan ID card, or a plan letter with 4Rx data, submit claims to that payer. *If the patient does not have a Part D plan ID card or plan letter, go to step 2.*

2 Submit an E1 Transaction
Submit a query to Medicare's online eligibility query system. If a telephone number for contract X0001 is returned, the patient is enrolled but the 4Rx data are not available; in this case use the 4Rx data in this brochure. If the query returns a Bank ID Number (BIN) and Processor Control Number (PCN), submit to the plan indicated. If the query returns a contract ID and help-desk number, contact the plan for the 4Rx data. *If the query does not return plan enrollment, go to step 3.*

3 Verify Eligibility for Medicare and either Medicaid or LIS
If the patient cannot provide proof of eligibility, don't submit the claim to the LI NET Program. Instead, refer the patient to his or her State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP). *If the patient is eligible for the LI NET Program, go to step 4.*

4 Submit Claim to the LI NET Program
