Title XIX Inpatient Hospital Reimbursement Plan

R. Long-term Ventilator-dependent Patients Admitted Prior to October 1, 2012

Payment for ventilator-dependent patients admitted to the hospital prior to October 1, 2012 will continue to be reimbursed on a per diem basis until they are discharged from the hospital. For hospitals with these patients, for rate years beginning October 1, 2012, and thereafter, the per diem in effect in the preceding year will be increased by the percentage increase of the most recent Medicare Inpatient Hospital PPS Market Basket Update as of October 1 of each year as published in the Federal Register. All patients admitted to a hospital on or after October 1, 2012 will be reimbursed under the APR-DRG methodology.

S. Post-Payment Review

All claims paid under the APR-DRG payment methodology are subject to post-payment review.

T. Payments Outside of the DRG Base Payment

The following payments are made outside of, and in addition to, the DRG base payment:

Long Acting Reversible Contraceptives (LARCs) and their insertion at the time of delivery will be reimbursed separately from the APR-DRG payment. A separate outpatient claim may be submitted by the hospital for reimbursement for LARCs and their insertion at the time of delivery. Reimbursement for LARCs and their insertion at the time of delivery will be based on the CMS approved Physician Administered Drugs and Implantable Drug System Devices and the Physician Fee Schedule reimbursement methodology as described in Attachment 4.19-B.
