This sheet is NOT to be submitted with the “NADAC Request for Medicaid Reimbursement Review” form below to Myers and Stauffer, LLC. (Mississippi DOM is not affiliated with Myers and Stauffer.) The attached form should be submitted to Myers and Stauffer in the event you have a drug price change that is not reflected in the posted NADAC files located at the [Pharmacy Drug Pricing Page](#). Please read below for instructions.

When submitting the NADAC Request for Medicaid Reimbursement to Myers and Stauffer, LLC, submit it to Mississippi DOM also. Mississippi DOM will NOT forward your request to the NADAC Help Desk. The form below should be emailed to info@mslcrps.com with “cc” to Gail.McCorkle@medicaid.ms.gov at Mississippi DOM.

Submit the form below with a copy of your current purchase records that confirms your acquisition costs. All fields in the NADAC Request for Medicaid Reimbursement form must be completed for proper submission.

Please note that the Help Desk will not address pharmacy inquiries into specific state claim reimbursement related questions or concerns.

Helpful Instructions

- 1) Copies of invoices or screen shots of a wholesaler's website are acceptable if they show the following: the current price quote, NDC of the drug, and time-date stamp. Contact the NADAC Help Desk for more complete instructions.
- 2) The weekly NADAC file is officially released on Wednesdays. If an update is needed, all inquiries received by the NADAC Help Desk between Friday at noon until the following Friday at noon will be reflected on the following week's NADAC file.
- 3) Remember NADAC is based on a national average of quotes collected from retail community pharmacy invoice costs. If a pharmacy cannot purchase a certain drug at or below the NADAC price, they are encouraged to discuss this with their respective wholesaler or buying group.
- 4) The NADAC is based on average of cost observations nationally and will not cover a specific provider's cost in every individual case.
- 5) Most common reasons a NADAC may change weekly instead of monthly may be due to provider inquiries to the NADAC Help Desk or the WAC rate changes on a brand drug which triggers the Brand NADAC to be recalculated.

- 5) Please note that the NADAC file is updated on a weekly basis. Each month, a new file is posted to reflect findings from the previous month's survey results incorporating the weekly price changes that have occurred in the interim weeks before the next monthly NADAC file. - 6) The [NADAC Equivalency Metrics](#) (PDF 120.15 KB) are published on a quarterly basis and are intended to be utilized for analyzing and monitoring the NADAC pricing relationship to compendia drug pricing values.
