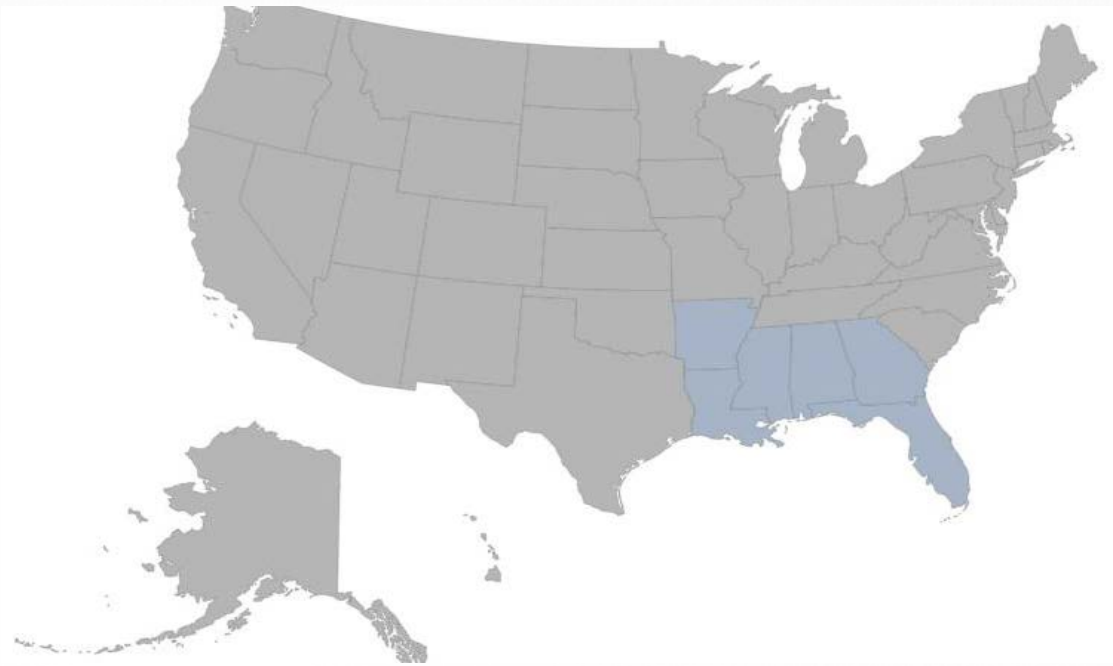

U.S. Department of Health & Human Services Best Practices

- Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) authorized by Congress to convene U.S. Preventive Services Task Force
 - Panel of national experts in prevention and medicine make evidence-based recommendations about clinical preventive services, screenings, counseling services, and preventive medications
 - All recommendations published on Task Force's Web site and/or in peer-reviewed journal
 - Recommendations assigned a letter grade based on strength of evidence and balance of benefits and harms
 - Task Force does not consider costs of preventive service when determining recommendation
- Annual report to Congress
