DOM procurement staff reviewed each submitted bid to ensure the submitted bids met each requirement to be deemed responsive as set forth in IFB #20200515. The procurement staff determined that both bids received were responsive.

<u>Responsible</u>

DOM Procurement staff reviewed the two (2) bids and determined that both bids met the minimum qualification requirements to be considered responsible bidders.

Ranking of Bids

Following completion of the review process, the qualifying bids were officially ranked based on the lowest, responsive and responsible bid. The ranking is as follows:

2.	KEPRO	\$5,206.201.00

Recommendation

Based on the foregoing, Maximus submitted the lowest, responsive and responsible bid. The Office of Procurement recommends that IFB #20200515, the Pre-Admission Screening and Resident Review (PASRR) contract be awarded as follows:
