Notice to Participants & Caregivers

The Mississippi Division of Medicaid's (DOM) Office of Long Term Services and Supports requests your feedback on the implementation of electronic visit verification, as required by the 21st Century Cures Act. This Act requires state Medicaid agencies to implement a system that automates data

- The Participant receiving the service
- Date the service begins and ends
- Time the service begins and ends
- Location of the service
 Type of service performed
 Providers of the service

DOM is seeking input regarding upcoming changes from participants, caregivers, and other community stakeholders.

New EVV Software Upgrade

For some waiver program groups, DOM has already started the EVV process. In 2021, DOM will upgrade and expand EVV tools with new CareVisit software, which includes:

- Member/Participant Self-Service Portal to view scheduled provider care visits
- Access for sending secure, private messages directly to your Provider and Case Manager
- CareVisit Mobile App to review visit dates and times from your smartphone
- Streamlined timekeeping of provider services, reducing the need for paper records
