

The contract is amending the following Articles:

- a) Article 1, Scope of Work, Attachment A I. Background, Table 1 and the paragraph directly under the table to replace Conduent with Gainwell as the fiscal agent performing the services.
- b) Article XXIX, INSPECTIONS: modified which representatives are authorized to have the right to inspect records.

The aforesaid services are a continued need for DOM and will be renewed for an optional one (1) year term. There is one (1) remaining one-year renewal optional available on this contract.
