

The contractor will provide services for the statewide administration of the Mississippi Coordinated Access Network (MSCAN), a coordinated care program for Mississippi Medicaid beneficiaries.

The amount noted above is the estimated spend value over the course of the one year contract period and does not reflect a not to exceed contract value. DOM is not able to determine the number of Member Months/beneficiaries that will be applicable to each coordinated care organization. Amendment #1 includes spend for 5/2/2023 – 10/25/2023 for \$496,074,041.36 for a contract total of \$1,615,091,805.36.

DOM is currently awaiting the outcome of the MSCAN RFQ #20211210 protests before Public Procurement Review Board. It is in the best interest of the State to enter an emergency contract to continue to perform these member services. UHC has agreed to provide the services for the updated capitated rate set by DOM's contracted actuary, as described in the amended contract.
