The Contractor will provide services for the statewide administration of the Mississippi Coordinated Access Network (MSCAN), a coordinated care program for Mississippi Medicaid beneficiaries.

Because DOM is not able to determine the number of Member Months that will be applicable to each CCO ahead of the contract period, an estimated value is used for the initial contract period and an as of spend date will be used as the value at each amendment for informational purposes only. The estimated contract payment amount for the initial term is \$3,760,809,928 per CCO contract, and includes state directed payments.

The initial contract period is four (4) years beginning August 12, 2024, and will end August 11, 2028, with two (2) optional one-year renewal periods. The initial contract period includes a one-year implementation period, with a three (3) year operational period.
