DOM determined that the services were below fair market value and provided its determination to PPRB. A contract between governmental entities requires Public Procurement Review Board (PPRB) approval.	
NSPARC center has 15 years of experience as an independent evaluator. NSPARC has the expertise, data analysis, research, and program evaluations that will aid DOM in meeting CMS requirements for the Section 1115 Demonstration waiver which is statutorily required in accordance with 42 CFR § 431.424. Requirements will focus on measurable goals and quantifiable hypotheses to determine the success of the demonstration in meeting its objectives; and therefore, meets the agency's need to these services.	
Per the terms of the contract, DOM contracted with MSU/NSPARC from September 1, 2024, to August 31, 2028, with one (1) year optional renewal. The total contract award amount is not to exceed \$100,800.00.
