Baby showers are held throughout the state where expecting and new mothers can receive information about having a healthy pregnancy, postpartum care and infant care. Personal Care Managers who are available telephonically to provide education and coaching, also embedded into clinics and available for home visits. Special programs are available for Sickle Cell, NICU, Behavioral Health, and transplants. | Quick access to dental benefits, ID cards, and important resources through the My Molina Dental App. Pregnancy Program: To help high-risk mothers avoid premature birth, this program provides tools for a healthier pregnancy and baby.
