

Buprenorphine Prescribing Guidance for Medication Assisted Treatment



PROVIDER SUMMARY SHEET

DIAGNOSIS REQUIREMENTS:

- Treatment must be for opioid use disorder, NOT PAIN.
- Opioid-related disorder ICD-10 codes must be found in medical claims or present on the prescription and entered by the pharmacist with the prescription claim.

BUPRENORPHINE/NALOXONE PRODUCTS

- Maximum daily dose: 24mg higher doses require prior authorization
- Quantity limits (films/tablets):
 - buprenorphine/naloxone 2mg-0.5mg: 3 units/day*
 - buprenorphine/naloxone 8mg-2mg: 3 units/day
 - buprenorphine/naloxone 12mg-3mg: 2 units/day
 - buprenorphine/naloxone 4mg-1mg: 1 unit/day*
 * quantity limits are limited for dose optimization

BUPRENORPHINE PRODUCTS

- Maximum daily dose: 16mg higher doses require prior authorization
- Quantity limits (tablets):
 - buprenorphine 2mg: 3 units/day*
 - o buprenorphine 8mg: 2 units/day
 - * quantity limits are limited for dose optimization

Refer to the Universal Preferred Drug List for preferred/nonpreferred status. Brixadi, Sublocade, and Zubsolv require prior authorization.
