Summary of Services Included in the EAP Counseling Program

- Services are provided to covered employees and dependents covered under your benefits package
- Evaluation and assessment
- Brief counseling/psychotherapy
- Referral to employee's preferred provider network - as needed
- Timely scheduling of appointments
- Crisis intervention via telephone – as needed
- Virtual appointments
- Confidential management of clinical information
