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The Mississippi Division of Medicaid (DOM) issued a Request for Applications (RFA) to establish a contract with a qualified applicant to provide Certified Public Accountant (CPA) services in support of the Office of Managed Care Financial Oversight. This position supports critical financial oversight functions, including analysis, reporting, and compliance activities related to Medicaid managed care programs.

The submission deadline to receive applications, resumes, and required documentation was April 17, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. CST. DOM received one (1) application submission.

Procurement staff reviewed the submission, and the applicant was deemed responsive and responsible in accordance with the requirements set forth in the RFA. The application was evaluated and determined to meet and exceed all minimum qualifications. The applicant demonstrated extensive experience in Medicaid and managed care financial oversight, including Medical Loss Ratio (MLR) analysis, state-directed payment programs, Quality Incentive Payment Program (QIPP) reporting, and financial compliance monitoring.

## **Recommendation**

Based on the evaluation process and findings, DOM intends to award the contract to: **James A. Post**.

Mr. Post is a licensed Certified Public Accountant with more than 10 years of progressively responsible professional accounting experience. His background reflects significant expertise in financial analysis, data management, and regulatory compliance within Medicaid programs. His experience and qualifications demonstrate the capability to successfully perform the required services in support of DOM's financial oversight functions.

The proposed contract term is five (5) years, beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2031, the contract may be renewed for successive one-year periods, subject to applicable approvals, unless either party provides written notice of termination at least 30 days prior to the expiration of the then-current term.

DOM intends to submit the contract to the Public Procurement Review Board (PPRB), Office of Personal Service Contract Review (OPSCR) by Wednesday, May 6, 2026, for consideration of approval at the June 3, 2026, Board meeting.
