
Rendering Providers on Claims

When submitting information about the rendering provider on any claim, the NPI for the rendering provider should be listed, along with their correct taxonomy code. Mississippi Medicaid provides a tool anyone can use to look up provider information contained in the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS).

Provider Look-up Tool

*Note: This tool is not in real time and is updated twice a month.

- ❖ It is important to note the rendering provider linkage to the billing provider. Depending on the **Billing provider type**, a rendering provider must be **linked** to or affiliated with the Billing NPI submitted on the claim. This allows the **group** provider to bill for the services rendered by the individual. Group providers can check individual provider affiliation on their **Admin** group provider portal. They can add individual providers, remove, or update information.

EOB 1051 – Rendering Provider Not on Provider Database

Common Causes:

- **No NPI:** An NPI must accompany the taxonomy when listing the rendering provider.

Explanation of Benefits (EOB)

Error 1051 will have the following explanation of benefits (Claim Header Error):

EOB	Description
1109	Rendering Provider is not a Certified Provider.

Example: Rendering NPI not submitted on the claim:

Render Provider ID	
Render Prov Taxonomy	363L00000X
Render Prov Taxonomy Submitted	

Error 1007 – Rendering Provider Number/Service Location Not on File

Common Causes:

- **No NPI:** An NPI must accompany the taxonomy when listing the rendering provider on the detail line of the claim.
- **Provider is Ineligible:** The Rendering provider must be enrolled with MS Medicaid and their account must be active during the dates of service. Rendering provider affiliation dates must be during the dates of service.

Explanation of Benefits (EOB)

Error 1007 will have the following explanation (Claim Detail Error):

EOB	Description
0040	Rendering provider ID is not on file.
