DOM issued RFA #20260220 on February 20, 2026, seeking qualified applicants for the position of Program Coordinator of the Cell and Gene Therapy Access Model. This position serves a critical role in implementing, managing, and operationalizing the CGT Access Model, including responsibilities related to access, reimbursement, patient and caregiver coordination, and data reporting to ensure optimal outcomes for Medicaid beneficiaries.

The initial contract term for the services required herein shall **begin on June 4, 2026, and end on April 30, 2031**. This contract will be subject to renewals, under the same prices, terms, and conditions as in the initial contract, for successive one-year periods unless either party provides written notice of termination at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the then-current term. The total duration of this initial contract shall not exceed five (5) years, and the total initial contract value shall not exceed \$545,163.80.
