

The Contractor will provide services for the statewide administration of the Mississippi Coordinated Access Network (MSCAN) and the Mississippi Children's Health Insurance Program (MSCHIP), coordinated care programs for Mississippi children.

The amount noted above is the estimated spend value over the course of the four-year initial contract period and does not reflect a not to exceed contract value. DOM is not able to determine the number of Member Months/beneficiaries that will be applicable to each coordinated care organization.

The changes are limited to correcting scrivener’s errors, clarifying existing definitions, expectations, legal requirements, and contract requirements, incorporating federally required CHIP State Plan updates, and revising termination language to better protect the DOM financially during the multi-year unwinding process if a current vendor is not awarded a future contract. The amendment does not change the scope of services but instead clarifies the existing scope and establishes reasonable termination parameters that would have been anticipated by RFQ respondents during the procurement process. All other terms and conditions remain the same.

The initial period of performance for the contract shall be August 12, 2024 – August 11, 2028. DOM may exercise, under the same terms and conditions as the existing Contract, an option for two remaining one-year extensions.
