TMaH Attestation

This document is for providers who are eligible for the Transforming Maternal Health (TMaH) attestation and would like to be part of the initiative.

When eligible, the TMaH link is displayed under the Provider section and will be labeled “TMaH Attestation.”

The TMaH Attestation link will display only when all of the following conditions are met:

- The provider’s Account Administrator is logged into the secure portal. The TMAH attestation link will not be displayed to delegate account holders.
- The provider is associated with a taxonomy that is eligible to participate in TMaH.
- The provider has an active MSCAN contract status and is not currently enrolled in the TMaH program.

To attest for the TMaH initiative, complete the following steps:

1. The account administrator must log into the **Provider Portal**. The link is not displayed for delegates.
2. At the Home page, click **TMaH Attestation** in the Provider section.

An AE is identified based on the Tax Identification Number (TIN) of a Participant Organization, which serves as the single legal entity that forms a business relationship with the State Medicaid Agency (SMA) or a Managed Care Organization (MCO) for purposes of participation in the TMaH VBP Model.

3. Check the box at the end of the attest statement after reading the terms.
