Thank you for your thorough review of the Mississippi Medicaid's Comprehensive Two-Year Revalidation Strategy.

Non-NPI Providers:

DOM can confirm the list shared within the Mississippi Division of Medicaid Provider Revalidation Strategy letter dated June 3, 2026 is comprehensive and as such, the listed providers are the only non-NPI provider types permitted to enroll without an NPI regardless of risk level.

Public-Facing Data and Reporting:

The listings are available from the DOM homepage ([Home - Mississippi Division of Medicaid](#)) by selecting the third bullet (revalidation) or the first bullet (recredentialing) under the Providers label. The Provider Six-Month Revalidation Due List and Provider Six-Month Recredentialing Due List are typically updated twice each month. As a result, the information contained within the links provided below will remain valid only until the next scheduled update.
